2022-23 Raider Area Choir Booster Club Senior Scholarship Guidelines

The Raider Area Choir Booster Club is proud to present the annual senior choir scholarships to deserving seniors enrolled in choir at Wylie East. The following information describes the application and judging process. Questions may be directed to a WEHS Choral Director or the RACBC President.

Instructions

Students shall complete the attached application in its entirety and return to Dr. Dame by the deadline listed on the application. Failure to complete all parts of the application process shall result in disqualification. The scholarship application will contain student information (to be kept independent of the rest of the process), allows for students to describe their history in the choral program, contains two blank teacher recommendation forms, and includes an essay prompt.

Judging

Student information will be kept confidential throughout the judging process. Applications will be referred to by number with the student name and identifying number kept by the RACBC Executive Board. Board members whose children have applied for the RACBC Senior Choir Scholarship shall be excused from all aspects of the scholarship process.

Applications and essays shall be scored independently by three (3) judges with knowledge and appreciation of Wylie East Choral Activities. Judges will rank the candidates from first to last based on their history within the choral program, teacher recommendations, and essay. Judges shall review all students who meet all application requirements. The directors will not be involved in the scholarship review process.

Ties shall be broken in the order of: (1) post-secondary music participation (i.e., choral ensemble participation in college or community organizations, music major/minor, etc.), (2) years of experience in the WEHS Choral Department, (3) academic GPA.

Scholarship Guidelines

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Students must be a senior enrolled full-time at Wylie East.
- 2. Students must be enrolled in choir for a minimum of two (2) years, including their senior year.
- 3. Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 4. Students must submit two (2) recommendations from a Wylie East teacher (cannot include choir).
- 5. Students must participate in UIL Concert & Sight-Reading at least two (2) years.
- 6. Students must participate in TMEA All-State Auditions or Solo & Ensemble Contest at least once.
- 7. Students must complete the application in its entirety (including essays) and submit prior to the deadline.

Awards

The RACBC will award up to eight (8) scholarships for varying amounts ranging from \$250-\$1000 each. Scholarships may not be "need" based, but those students receiving a full scholarship from a university, college, or outside organization will not be eligible for the RACBC Senior Choir Scholarship.

Awards shall be sent directly to the financial aid office of the school selected by the award recipient. Award recipients shall notify the RACBC Booster Board by June 1 of their school selection. Failure to meet this deadline will result in forfeiture of award funds.

Application must be turned in to Dr. Dame in the Choir Room by **Friday, March 17, 2023**. For the Teacher Recommendation, provide the form and an envelope (well in advance) for your recommending teacher. He/She will return the recommendation to Dr. Dame's mailbox *in the sealed envelope* **by Friday, March 17, 2023**.
